【Purpose】

To recruit highly capable individuals and foster outstanding researchers and engineers, as well as to promote student exchanges with overseas institutions, an Recommendation-based Entrance Examination for Japanese Government (MEXT) Scholarship has been established.

1 Application Eligibility・Nomination Requirements

A person who falls under (1) and (2) below.

- (1) This refers to non-Japanese nationals who, by the application deadline, have been approved to study for two years starting from October 2024 as Japanese Government (MEXT) Scholarship (University Recommendation/Special Selection), and who have excellent academic records and good personal qualities. They must also be recommended by the president or principal of their current institution and be able to confirm their commitment to enrolling in our university if accepted.
- (2) A person who falls under any of the following items ①, ②, ③, and ④
 - ① Individuals who have completed 16 years of school education in a foreign country.
 - ② Individuals who have completed a 16-year course of study according to the education system of a foreign country by taking courses through distance learning offered by a foreign school of that country, while being in Japan.
 - ③ Individuals who have completed a course offered by a foreign university at an educational institution in Japan that has been accredited in the education system of the said foreign country and separately designated by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology of Japan (hereinafter referred to as MEXT Minister). This is limited to courses whose completion is considered equivalent to completing 16 years of school education in the said foreign country.
 - ④ Individuals who hold a degree equivalent to a bachelor's degree at a foreign university or school by completing a curriculum of 3 years or more. Individuals who have completed a curriculum by taking courses offered through distance learning by the foreign institution in Japan or have completed a curriculum at an educational institution in Japan that has been accredited by the education system of the said foreign country and, as designated in ③, are also permitted. This is only applicable to foreign universities or schools whose education and research have been evaluated comprehensively and have been certified by the government or responsible agency in the said foreign country or those that have been separately designated as equivalent ones by the MEXT Minister.

③ Individuals who have completed a course offered by a foreign university at an educational institution in Japan that has been accredited in the education system of said foreign country and separately designated by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology of Japan (hereinafter referred to as MEXT Minister). This is limited to courses whose completion is considered equivalent to completing 16 years of school education in said foreign country.

④ Individuals who hold a degree equivalent to a bachelor's degree at a foreign university or school by completing a curriculum of 3 years or more. Individuals who have completed a curriculum by taking courses offered through distance learning by the foreign institution in Japan or have completed a curriculum at an educational institution in Japan that has been accredited by the education system of said foreign country and, as designated in ③, are also permitted. This is only applicable to foreign universities or schools whose education and research have been evaluated comprehensively and have been certified by the government or responsible agency in said foreign country or those that have been separately designated as equivalent ones by the MEXT Minister.

⑤ Individuals who have completed a 15-year school education program in a foreign country and have also obtained the required credits with excellent grades for this graduate school.

⑥ Individuals who have completed a course offered by a foreign university with high marks at an educational institution in Japan, which has been accredited by the education system of the said foreign country and separately designated by the MEXT Minister. The completion of course with high marks must be recognized by our graduate school. This is limited to courses whose completion is considered equivalent to completing 15 years of school education in said foreign country.

⑦ A person aged 22 or above who has been recognized as having a level of academic ability equal to or higher than average university graduates by the Preliminary Eligibility Screening of our graduate school as explained below.

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2 Admission Eligibility Screening (Applicable persons only)

International students who wish to apply based on Application Eligibility (3) ⑤, ⑥, ⑦ must undergo individual admission eligibility screening via documentation beforehand. Please submit the required Admission Eligibility Screening documents (listed below) in one package to the Admissions Office, Faculty of Engineering, Yamagata University by the designated deadline.

Note Individual admission eligibility screening is not required for those who are expected to graduate from a university in March 2026 (or September 2025) and those who have graduated from a university.

- 1 Examination Voucher
 - (1) Please ensure you bring your examination voucher on the day of the examination. It must be shown when you enter the examination area.
 - (2) Please ensure you are always in possession of your examination voucher and follow any instructions given by staff members.
 - (3) If you have forgotten your examination voucher on the day of the examination, please speak to the staff at the examination site and perform the necessary procedures to receive a temporary copy.
 - (4) If you lose your examination voucher, please immediately contact the individual in-charge of entrance examinations at Yamagata University's Faculty of Engineering.
 - (5) The Examination Voucher will be required as part of admission procedures. Please ensure you maintain a copy of it until you receive your results.
- 2 Poor weather etc. may cause transport delays. Please confirm the weather and any effects it may be having on transport. Each applicant is responsible for taking suitable measures to be at the examination site on time by, for example, arriving at Yonezawa City the day prior to the examination.
- 3 Please ensure you arrive at the examination site 30 minutes prior to the start of the examination.
- 4 If you arrive late, please speak to the staff at the examination site.
- 5 If you arrive at the examination site more than 20 minutes late, you will not be allowed into the examination room.
- 6 If a transport accident/disaster occurs on the day of the examination, the examination start time may be changed.
- 7 Important information on written examinations:
 - (1) During the examination, in addition to the Examination Voucher, the following items are allowed to be placed on the desk: pencils (mechanical pencils are also allowed), erasers, pencil sharpeners (excluding electric ones, large-sized ones or such made of knives), watches (excluding dictionaries, calculators, devices with indistinguishable functions, those with second hand ticking, kitchen timers, learning timer or large ones), rulers(except for those that are foldable and have protractor functions), eyeglasses, handkerchiefs, tissues (taken out only from bags or boxes), and eye drops.
 - (2) In the examination room, you are not allowed to borrow or share other people's belongings.
 - (3) Leaving the examination room during the test is not permitted. If you become ill or have an unavoidable situation during the test, please raise your hand and follow the instructions of the supervisor.
 - (4) The answers of individuals who are found to have engaged in dishonest conduct will be invalidated.
 - (5) If the examination registration number is not correctly entered in the designated space on the answer sheet, the subject in question will not be graded and may be considered as not taken.
 - (6) If the characters or diagrams written on the answer sheet are messy or faint, making them difficult to read during grading, accurate scoring may not be possible.
- 8 Before entering the examination room, all electronic devices must be turned off, including cell phones, smart phones, wearable devices(smart watch, smart glass, etc), tablets, electronic dictionaries, IC recorders, earphones, music players, etc. For electronic devices with an alarm function, turn off the alarm setting and then turn the device off. - 3 Regarding Security Trade Controls

Yamagata University stipulates the Security Trade Control Guidelines for Yamagata University based on the Foreign Exchange and Foreign Trade Act, etc., and manages the technology provided and goods exported from the university. In order to manage these exports, we may ask you to submit a declaration relating to the applicability of circumstances (designated types) that are strongly influenced by foreign governments and corporations.

If the regulations apply, the university may need to apply for a permit from the Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry (METI), and as a result, technology provisions may not be implemented swiftly.
