## Safe Student Lifestyles and Preventing New Coronavirus Infection Regarding out-of-prefecture visitors entering the campus

Yamagata University's Faculty of Engineering, Graduate School of Science and Engineering, and Graduate School of Organic Materials Systems To All Students,

Currently, we are banning faculty members from traveling outside of the prefecture and also campus visitors from outside of the prefecture. However, in light of the current situation where infections are increasing in metropolitan areas and infections are also occurring in Yonezawa. For the time being, students should take the following actions to further ensure prevention.

• If you leave the prefecture for reasons such as job hunting and regulations, you will not be allowed to enter the Yonezawa campus for 14 days after returning to your apartment or home, and must study independently at home.

• If you need to enter the campus due to special circumstances, you must consult with an advisor or supervisor and follow their instructions.

• While going out during home study, there are no restrictions, but you must take thorough precautions to prevent infection and ensure the safety of yourself and others.

• If you feel uneasy about your physical condition, etc., please contact your family and also contact the dedicated e-mail address for countermeasures against coronavirus, or a nearby faculty member.

• Regardless of changes in physical condition, record travel to and from the prefecture and also activities done during home study as accurately as possible.

The end date for these measures is April 30<sup>th</sup>, but they may be extended further depending on the situation. Always get the latest information on the Yamagata University website, the Faculty of Engineering website, etc.
