

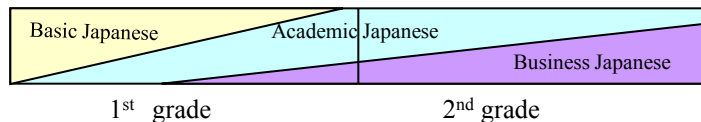

From the acquisition of knowledge in Japanese to the usage of it. *Change!*

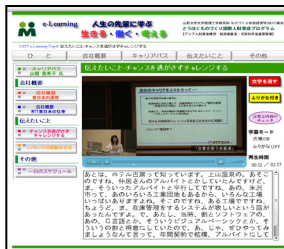
